



K2 Curriculum Guidelines

Each child learns a little differently; while one child loves story time, another prefers to play with blocks or enjoys painting. Each area is important and one area overlaps the other. To provide fun learning experiences for our 2 year olds, we have included a monthly theme and other activities that teach basic concepts. Every Friday we have chapel where our students have the opportunity to hear truths from God's Word.

Our activities include:

- Social skills: They learn to share, take turns, sit patiently, follow directions and care for others
- Weekly Bible lessons
- Read aloud books
- Letter recognition
- 1-10 numbers recognition
- Counting practice
- Colors
- Shapes
- Fine motor skills: coloring, painting and pre-writing
- Logic skills: puzzles, size sorting, table games
- Singing songs
- Arts and crafts
- Name Recognition
- Talk about the weather and the seasons at appropriate times during the year.
- Talk about themselves (i.e. where they live, the members of their extended family and events in their lives both past and present.
- Outdoor play to improve coordination and develop their muscles. Group activities on the playground also teach children cooperation.

Each child is learning important lessons as he/she works, learns and plays.
